**SUBJECT:** Proposed Prohibition of waiting and Bus Stop Clearway - Aspal Lane, Beck Row

I have read your proposal and I understand that there is a need for change. However, I do not believe that the proposed plan is the way to make that change. While it is true that there is parking available behind the properties, that parking is not adequate. There is only room for one vehicle per family, and we share our parking with three other families. Since there are no other car parks available in the nearby vicinity, it would be an extreme inconvenience if we are prohibited from parking on the curb.

That being said, there is a safety concern here. Instead of prohibiting parking, I propose that speed humps be built. I have witnessed, on several occasions, people traveling at excess speeds down Aspal Lane. If there were speed humps in place, then people would be forced to slow down to a safer speed. This would also remove the safety concern of the vehicles parked on the curb.

I cannot speak for everyone, but I know that I park partially on the footway to make more room for the traffic. If there were speed humps, then I would feel safer parking completely in the road. If everyone did that, then there would no longer be a problem for the mobility impaired.

Due to a lack of viable alternatives, we park on Aspal Lane. Prohibiting that parking will have severe impacts on the residents who need that parking space.
