SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (HORSECROFT ROAD, BURY ST EDMUNDS) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 201-

Suffolk County Council, in exercise of its powers under Section 84(1) (a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:

1. No person shall drive any vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 mph in any direction on Horsecroft Road, Bury St Edmunds, from a point approximately 22 metres south west of the centre of its junction with Horringer Road in a south-westerly and then southerly direction to a point approximately 22 metres west of its junction with Longacre Gardens, a distance of approximately 358 metres.
2. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
3. This Order may be cited as the Suffolk County Council (Horsecroft Road, Bury St Edmunds) (20 mph Speed Limit) Order 201- and shall come into operation on * .

NOTICE OF PROPOSED 20 MPH SPEED LIMIT WITH ROAD HUMPS, BURY ST EDMUNDS

SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (HORSECROFT ROAD, BURY ST EDMUNDS) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 201-

Suffolk County Council proposes to make the above-named order under Section 84 (1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to introduce a 20 mph speed limit on Horsecroft Road, Bury St Edmunds, between a point approximately 22 metres south of its junction with Horringer Road to a point 22 metres south of Longacre Gardens.

In association with the speed limit it is intended to construct 4 round-topped road humps along this length of road, two measuring 3.7m x 4.9m x 65mm and two measuring 3.7m x 4.2 m x 65 mm.

These proposals were previously advertised by St Edmundsbury Borough Council under an expired highways agency agreement.

A copy of the draft order and a plan showing the length of road affected and location of the road humps, together with the Council's reasons for these proposals, may be inspected at the offices of St Edmundsbury Borough Council at Western Way, Bury St. Edmunds, 9.00 a.m. - 5.00 p.m. Monday - Friday.

Objections and any other representations concerning this order or the construction of the road humps, specifying the grounds on which they are made, must be in writing and must reach Heather Miller (Legal Services) by 27 May 2011. Please bear in mind that any such correspondence cannot be regarded as confidential and may be inspected by any interested party.
