Suffolk County Council ('the Council') in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2) and 2(1) to (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:

1. The restrictions, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order are in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any other enactment and any exception or exemption to the provisions of this Order is without prejudice to the provisions of any other enactment.
2. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in the A1092 High Street or the A1092 Poole Street, Cavendish, to enter The Green service road at its north eastern and south western junctions respectively.
4. This Order may be cited as the Suffolk County Council (Parish of Cavendish) (The Green – Service Road) (Prohibition of Entry) Order 201- and shall come into operation on *

Suffolk County Council proposes to make the above order under Sections 1 and 2 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended. The effect of the order will be to prohibit any vehicle from entering The Green service road, Cavendish, at its north eastern junction with High Road and its south western junction with Poole Street. The wide central access to the service road will not be affected.

(PROHIBITION OF ENTRY) ORDER 201-**

Statement of Reasons

It is proposed to introduce a prohibition of entry at the north eastern and south western end of the service road, The Green, to prohibit access from the A1092 High Street and Poole Street.

The proposals are intended to remove the dangerous vehicular / pedestrian conflict on the narrow access points onto the service road by allowing safe egress of traffic from the narrow service road and shopping area onto the main A1092. The wide central access point will remain two-way to allow access and egress.
