

**SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, FELIXSTOWE)
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING, PROHIBITION OF WAITING AND
LOADING, ON-STREET PARKING PLACES AND REVOCATION) ORDER 201-**

Suffolk County Council ('the Council') in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:

PART 1: INTERPRETATION

1. (1) In this Order

'licensed taxi' means a vehicle licensed by Suffolk Coastal District Council under the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 or the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976;

'driver' in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;

'owner' on relation to a vehicle, means the person by whom such a vehicle is kept and used;

'parking place' means any part of the road authorised by this Order to be used as a parking place;

'disabled person's vehicle' has the same meaning as in Section 142 of the Act of 1984;

'disabled person's badge' has the same meaning as in Regulation 2(1) of the Disabled Person's (Badges for Motor vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000;

'parking disc' means a device that:

- (a) is 125 millimetres square and coloured blue;
- (b) has been issued by a local authority and has not ceased to be valid; and
- (c) is capable of showing the quarter-hour period during which a period of waiting has begun.

2. For the purposes of this Order a vehicle shall be required as displaying:

- (a) a disabled person's badge in the relevant position when:
 - (i) the badge is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle; or
 - (ii) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle;

so that the front of the badge is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle.

- (b) a parking disc in the relevant position when:
 - (i) the disc is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle; or
 - (ii) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle;

so that, when marked to show the quarter-hour period during which a period of waiting began, that period is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle.

- 3. (1). Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.
- (2) The restrictions, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order are in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any other enactment and any exception or exemption to the provisions of this Order is without prejudice to the provisions of any other enactment.

PART 2: WAITING RESTRICTIONS

Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting

- 4. Except as provided in Article 7 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the length and sides of road specified under Type 1 in Schedule 1.
- 5. Except as provided in Article 7 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on the lengths and sides of road specified under Type 5 in Schedule 1.
- 6. Except as provided in Article 7 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday on the sides of road specified under Type 6 in Schedule 1.
- 7. (1) Nothing in Articles 4, 5 and 6 shall make it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the lengths and sides of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:
 - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) goods to be loaded or unloaded from the vehicle;
 - (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said lengths and sides of road; or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said lengths and sides of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for

the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications system as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;

- (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
- (2) Nothing in Articles 4, 5 and 6 shall make it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on the lengths and sides of roads referred to therein for a period not exceeding 3 hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same side of road on the same day).
8. Except as provided in Article 10, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 am and 6.00 pm on any day other than a Sunday on the sides of road specified under Type 22 in Schedule 1;
- (a) for a period of longer than 30 minutes; or
 - (b) if a period of less than 1 hour has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle on the same side of the road.
9. Except as provided in Article 10, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 am and 6.00 pm on any day other than a Sunday on the sides of road specified under Type 28 in Schedule 1;
- (a) for a period of longer than 1 hour; or
 - (b) if a period of less than 2 hours has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle on the same side of the road.
10. (1) Nothing in Articles 8 and 9 shall make it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:
- (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) goods to be loaded or unloaded from the vehicle
 - (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of road; or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said sides of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications system as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;

- (d) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
- (2) Nothing in Articles 8 and 9 shall make it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle, which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, to wait at any time on the sides of road referred to therein.

Prohibition of Waiting and Loading

- 11. Except as provided in Article 12 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the sides of road specified under Type 2 in Schedule 1.
- 12. Nothing in Article 11 shall make it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:
 - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
 - (b) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of road;
or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said sides of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications system as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.

PART 3: AUTHORISATION AND USE OF PARKING PLACES

- 13. (1) The parts of road specified in Column 1 of Schedules 2 and 3 are authorized to be used, subject to the following provisions of this Order, as parking places for such classes of vehicles, in such positions and on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to those parts of the road in the said Schedules.
- (2) Nothing in paragraph (1) of this Article shall restrict the power of the Council, for preventing obstruction of the streets, by order on the occasion of any public processions, rejoicing or illuminations, or where the streets are thronged or liable to be obstructed, to close any parking place.
- 14. The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in the parking places specified in Schedules 2 and 3 in a position other than that specified in those Schedules.

15. The driver of a vehicle shall not permit it to wait in a parking place specified in column 1 of Schedule 2 in a parking place designated for a disabled person's vehicle, or during the hours prescribed for a disabled persons' vehicle:
 - (a) unless it is a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge or a parking disc;
 - (b) for a period of longer than 3 hours;
 - (c) if a period of less than 4 hours has elapsed since the termination during the said hours of the last period of waiting (if any) by that vehicle.
16. The driver of a vehicle other than a licensed taxi shall not permit it to wait in a parking place specified in column 1 of Schedule 3 between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on any day on the side of road designated (a) in that Schedule; or between the hours of 7.00 p.m. and 3.00 a.m. on any day on the sides of road designated (b) and (c).
17. A driver of a vehicle shall not use the parking places specified in Column 1 of Schedules 2 and 3:
 - (a) so as unreasonably to prevent access to any premises adjoining the road, or the use of the road by other persons, or so as to be a nuisance; or
 - (b) when for preventing obstruction of the streets the Council shall by order made on the occasion of any public procession, rejoicing or illumination or when the streets are thronged or liable to be obstructed have closed any parking place specified in Column 1 of the said Schedules and exhibited a notice of such closing on or near the parking place.
18. The driver of a vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or depart from the parking place.
19. (1) No person shall use a vehicle, while it is in a parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near the parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services.
 - (2) No person shall use any part of a parking place or any vehicle left in a parking place:
 - (a) for sleeping, camping or cooking; or
 - (b) for the purpose of servicing or washing any vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from the parking place.
20. Subject to the proviso hereto, when a vehicle is left in a parking place in contravention of any of the provisions contained in Articles 14 to 17, a person authorised in that behalf by the Council may remove the vehicle or arrange for it to be removed from that parking place: provided that when a vehicle is waiting in a parking place in contravention of the provision of Article 14, a person authorized in that behalf by the Council may alter or cause to be altered the position of the vehicle in order that its position shall comply with that provision.

21. For the purpose of meeting the requirements of an emergency, a person authorised in that behalf by the Council or a police constable in uniform may alter or cause to be altered the position of a vehicle in a parking place or remove or arrange for the removal of a vehicle from a parking place.
22. Any person removing a vehicle or altering its position by virtue of Articles 20 or 21 may do so by towing or driving the vehicle or in such other manner as they may think necessary and may take such measures in relation to the vehicle as they may think necessary to enable them to remove it or alter its position, as the case may be.
23. When a person authorised by the Council removes or makes arrangements for the removal of a vehicle from a parking place by virtue of Article 20 or 21 they shall make such arrangements as may be reasonably necessary for the safe custody of the vehicle.

REVOCATIONS AND CITATION

26. The provisions of the County of East Suffolk (Undercliff Road West, Langer Road, Garrison Lane and Various Side Roads, Felixstowe) (Prohibited and Restricted Waiting) Order 1967, insofar as they relate to the waiting restriction on the side of road specified in Schedule 6, are hereby revoked.
27. The provisions of The County of East Suffolk (The Urban District of Felixstowe) (Hamilton Road, Orwell Road, Highfield Road, Crescent Road, Victoria Street, Ranelagh Road and Various Side Roads) (One-Way Traffic Regulation and Waiting Restriction) Order 1968, insofar as they relate to waiting restrictions on the lengths and sides of road specified in Schedule 7, are hereby revoked.
28. The provisions of The County of East Suffolk (The Urban District of Felixstowe) (Hamilton Road) (Restriction of Waiting) (Amendment) Order 1970, insofar as they relate to the waiting restriction on the side of road specified in Schedule 8, are hereby revoked.
29. The provisions of the Suffolk County Council (Parish of Felixstowe) (Various Roads) (Restriction of Waiting) Order 1976, insofar as they relate to waiting restrictions on the sides of road specified in Schedule 9, are hereby revoked.
30. The provisions of the Suffolk County Council (Parish of Felixstowe) (Various Streets) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1976, insofar as they relate to waiting restrictions on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 10, are hereby revoked
31. The provisions of the Suffolk County Council (Parish of Felixstowe) (High Street and Victoria Street) (Restriction of Waiting and Revocation) Order 1979, insofar as they

relate to waiting restrictions on the sides of road specified in Schedule 11, are hereby revoked.

32. The provisions of the Suffolk County Council (Parish of Felixstowe) (Various Streets) (One Way Traffic, Prohibition of Right Hand Turn and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1982, insofar as they relate to the waiting restriction on the side of road specified in Schedule 12, are hereby revoked
33. The provisions of the Suffolk County Council (Parish of Felixstowe) (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Revocation) Order 1983, insofar as they relate to waiting restrictions on the sides of road specified in Schedule 13, are hereby revoked.
34. The provisions of the Suffolk County Council (Parish of Felixstowe) (Hamilton Road and York Road) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Revocation) Order 1986, insofar as they relate to waiting restrictions on the side of road specified in Schedule 14, are hereby revoked
35. The provisions of the Suffolk County Council (Various Streets, Felixstowe) (Prohibition of Driving, Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and On-Street Parking Places) Order 1990, insofar as they relate to waiting restrictions on the sides of road specified in Schedule 15, are hereby revoked.
36. The provisions of the Suffolk County Council (Various Roads, Felixstowe) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Bus Stop Clearway, On-Street Parking Places and Revocation) Order 1994, insofar as they relate to waiting restrictions and to the parking place on the length and sides of road specified in Schedule 16, are hereby revoked.
