Dear Ms Miller,

Whilst I have No objection to the change from advisory to
enforceable parking places regarding the two outside
Lotus/Chestnut cottages.

I do feel however, that the hours/days proposed are excessive for
the reasons I list below-.

(1) When the advisory parking places were introduced outside
Lotus Cottage we were informed that this was to facilitate easier
access to the following shops Opticians, Hairdresser and
Dentist.

Two of these are no longer trading and the Opticians are seldom
open on Saturday mornings.

(2) Hall Street outside Lotus /Chestnut Cottage is much used in
the evening/weekends by customers of local restaurants/shops
(including the Co-op).

May I respectfully suggest that the enforceable parking outside
Lotus/Chestnut cottage should be between the hours of 0800 to
1800 Monday to Friday inclusive.

This would enable the spaces to be available for use at
evenings/wceekends for others as well as Blue Badge holders.
