

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1947.

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PERMISSION IS HEREBY GIVEN by the EAST SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL as the Local Planning Authority for the purposes of the above Act, to development in accordance with the application dated the 8th day of Feb, 1949

submitted by The Gipping Rural District Council, Council Offices, Buxton, Needham Market,

to for approval of an amended layout of fourteen houses

upon land situate at in the County of Suffolk

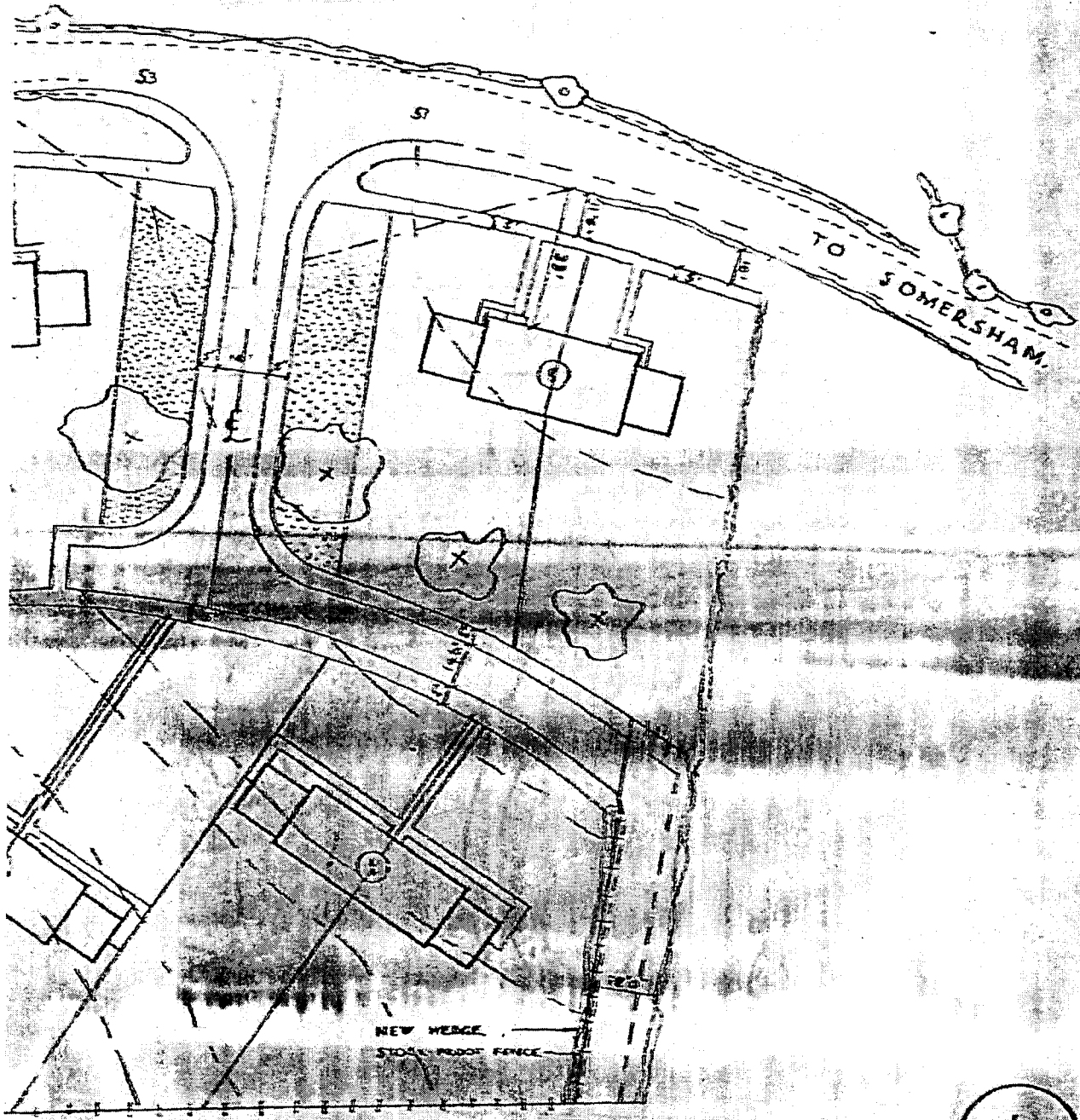
for the purpose of residential

SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS :-

1. To the applicant authority submitting for approval before work is commenced on the construction of the estate road detailed plans showing the type of construction and gradient proposed in respect of the estate road carriageway at its junction with the unclassified road.
2. To suitable provision being made for the disposal of surface water collected at the estate road.
3. To the level of the land in front of the visibility splay lines at the road junction not exceeding a height of 2 feet above the level of the carriageway of the unclassified road adjacent thereto and rising therefrom at a gradient not greater than the proposed estate road.

The reasons for the Council's decision to grant permission for the development, subject to compliance with the conditions hereinbefore specified are :-

1. In the interests of road safety.
2. So as not to interfere with the drainage of the area.
3. In the interests of road safety.
