Thank you for your message. I am sorry that documents were not available when you visited Endeavour House. The normal procedure is for the reception staff to phone me and I will bring them down. There are too many schemes in progress at any one time for it to be practical to store them all at Reception. I apologise for your wasted journey and attach the relevant documents for your information.

Your concerns about the proposals for Felixstowe Road have been noted. If these cannot be resolved by the scheme manager they will in due course be included in any report made to the Rights of Way Committee. This Committee considers both rights of way and traffic management proposals that are contested. The Committee's recommendations are then reported to the Portfolio Holder, Councillor Guy McGregor, for the Council's final decision on the proposals and in that case I will write to you again after the decision.

The dates of the next two committee meetings when these proposals are likely to be considered are 8 November 2012 and 16 January 2013.
