Please take this email as a formal objection to the proposed Restriction of Waiting Order 201 for the A1156 – Felixstowe Road.

The proposed restrictions are too draconian and are not, as far as I am aware, representative of the local residents.

As a Parish Councillor and resident of Felixstowe Road I have been instrumental in campaigning for the restrictions and canvassing the residents for their opinions on a survey.

The majority of residents wanted the restrictions to apply on a MONDAY to FRIDAY basis only. Weekends were never really seen as a problem. I believe the only time Saturdays were introduced to the proposal was

as a result of a few residents attending a Parish Council meeting in 2011, which I was unable to attend. I believe a vote may have been taken at that meeting.

If the proposed restrictions are implemented on Saturday mornings I believe they will have a detrimental impact on

- a) the residents for events such as childrens parties/family occasions where they are likely to have a number of cars visiting
- b) the local businesses on the Southern service road – e.g. Foxhall Garage and Bob Spalding Marine and other businesses operating from houses.

Therefore I would suggest that the restrictions should be implemented as proposed on a Monday to Friday basis, but NOT on Saturdays or Public Holidays. This will balance the needs of the residents and businesses.
