Liver Resection Services Are Changing, Have Your Say.

The Cambridgeshire, Norfolk and Suffolk Joint Scrutiny Committee is currently considering plans put forward by NHS England to create one specialist centre for liver cancer patients in the east of England. These changes mean that surgery for liver metastases - the spread of cancer from one organ or part of the body to another - would be performed at one specialist centre.

During their first meeting at the end of September, the Scrutiny Committee considered the quality of clinical evidence that underlies the proposals. Their second meeting on 29/11/2013 will consider the impact of the proposals on patients and carer experience and outcomes on their health and wellbeing.
