GCSE Grades for pupils attending EOTAS provision for Academic year 2012-13 and 2013-14

We have only got the data on Post 16 destinations for academic year 2012/13 as the 2013/14 data has not yet been collated. However, we do know that there were only 18 NEETs for the last academic year based on PRU destination data collected in July 2014.

PRU and EOTAS Attendance figures 2012/13 & 2013/14

Absence data for pupil referral units (PRUs) was collected termly for the first time in the spring 2014 School Census, previously this information was only collected annually. The data for the academic year 2013/14 will not be realised until March 2015.

The overall absence rate for pupil referral units nationally in autumn 2013 was 30.8 per cent. The data below shows that the Suffolk average for 2012/13 was 12.35% and in 2013/14 was 18.14% both significantly less than the national PRU average. However, the average absence rate has increased by 5.79% this academic year and where PRUs have low rate of attendance action is being taken.
