1. Suffolk County Council (Various Roads, Blundeston, Corton and Lowestoft) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Revocation) Order 201- (Agenda Item 05)

Committee Recommendation:

- a) In respect of Rotterdam Road in Lowestoft, on proposition from Councillor Chris Punt, seconded by Councillor Terry Clements, the Committee unanimously agreed that the Cabinet Member for Roads, Transport and Planning be recommended to approve the making of the Suffolk County Council (Various Roads, Blundeston, Corton and Lowestoft) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Revocation) Order 201 – as advertised.
- b) In respect of The Close in Corton, on proposition from Councillor Keith Patience, seconded by Councillor Terry Clements, the Committee unanimously agreed that the Cabinet Member for Roads, Transport and Planning be recommended to approve the making of the Suffolk County Council (Various Roads, Blundeston, Corton and Lowestoft) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Revocation) Order 201 – as advertised.
