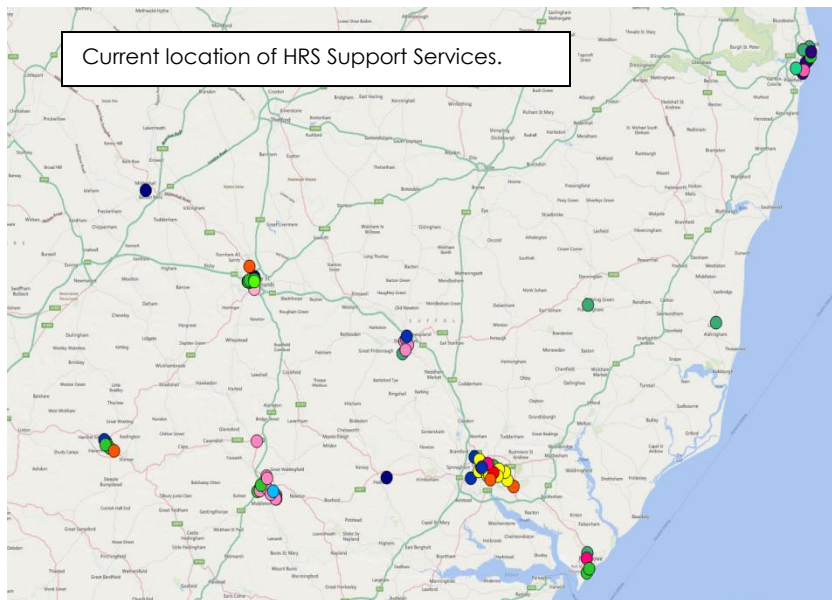


Housing Related Supported (HRS) Transformation

- Support is focussed on life skills: budgeting, cleaning, cooking, finding employment, education and training – by empowering and enabling people.
