For future consideration, access for emergency vehicle's remains a concern. When we moved here 26yrs ago there is an area, part pavement, extended to part Concrete in front of numbers 103-109 Sebert Road, which leads into Croyley Close, the entrance to which was designated KEEP CLEAR. Over the past few years this area has been allocated as Parking places which now denies access by any vehicles, not even sure how pushchairs get through! If this area was reinstated as Keep Clear it would be possible in an emergency to exit Sebert Road by this route.
