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Brief summary of report

1. The Suffolk Joint Learning Disability Strategy was approved by the Health and Wellbeing Board in July 2015. During that discussion the process used to develop the strategy was described and the approach to co-production was commended.
2. Having approved the priorities set out in the strategy, the Health and Wellbeing Board asked the Learning Disabilities Partnership to come back at a later date with their implementation plan. This report and the attachments describe how the implementation plan has been developed and sets out the actions and activities required to achieve the strategy's objectives.

Action recommended

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 3. The Board is asked to: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) support the approach to co-production being used to develop the strategy and implement the action plan; and b) agree the commitments included in the co-produced action plan supporting the strategy.
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Reason for recommendation

4. The action plan has been co-produced and takes a system-wide approach to achieving the ambitions set out in the strategy.

6. The Learning Disability Partnership will oversee the implementation of the Strategy action plan. The actions in the plan will require all partners to work together, including Suffolk County Council, NHS commissioners and

providers, independent sector providers and of course self advocates and family carers.

7. There are a number of appendices the Health and Wellbeing Board are referred to. These describe the process for developing the action plan, give examples of co-production in practice and which set out the actions partners are being asked to commit to.
