We the undernamed **strongly object** to the proposed cuts to the Suffolk Fire and Rescue Service. These proposed cuts will see the **loss of 6 fire engines, 1 fire station closed and the potential loss of 55 firefighters** throughout Suffolk.

These cuts include the loss of 1 fire engine and potentially 10 firefighters from Bury St Edmunds fire station.

We believe that these proposed cuts are unacceptable and should not happen.

The petition has received over 3,675 signatures and the petitioner has chosen to present the petition to Cabinet.
