Thank you for the opportunity to comment. We have seen an overall improvement, with our crews reporting few problems with access in the area since the parking restrictions have been introduced. I have asked our contractor to double check this with the crew concerned and will update you if there is anything contrary what I have advised.

I think there has been a couple of isolated problems accessing Bramblewood but that is the only one I know of. Access to Wentworth Drive was a reoccurring problem before, and I have not heard of any significant problems since.

As it is now six months since the lining was implemented have there been any reports to you of changes required? Have you decided upon any changes?

We are not aware of any major problems in fact most are very happy with the current situation.

At our last meeting we were given a couple of requests to forward to you for consideration

and these are as follows:-

- Entrance to Bramblewood needs extending round the corner by at least a cars length towards the shops as cars are parking on the corner making it difficult to see what is coming from the shops when exiting Bramblewood.
- Some of the lining in Broad Meadow needs repainting as it is several years old.

I have also had a couple of emails lately from Mr Gary Watkins of Wentworth Drive reporting that the bin lorry has been unable to get through to empty bins again. I have forwarded these emails to you separately you may already be aware.

If you could update me on anything I need to report back to the parish council I have a meeting on Monday 11th.
