### Information Bulletin

#### Routes which Officers have found to be not safe for an accompanied child

1. The Committee is asked to note the following applications which have been allowed.
2. The area where these applicants live is within the statutory walking distance from their Schools for children of their ages and thus, in accordance with the general policy, there is no entitlement to free transport for these children.
3. However, the applications in these cases were that free school transport should be provided on the grounds of the safety of the route factors, and have found to be not safe for an accompanied child pedestrian, therefore allowed.
