

**SUFFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, FRAMLINGHAM)  
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND REVOCATION) ORDER 2016**

Suffolk County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1 (1), 2 (1) to (3), 4 (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, (which said Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as 'the Act of 1984') and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:

**PART 1: INTERPRETATION**

1. (1) In this Order:

'disabled person's vehicle' has the same meaning as in Section 142 of the Act of 1984;

'disabled person's badge' has the same meaning as in Regulation 2(1) of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (England) Regulations 2000; and

'parking disc' means a device that:

- (a) is 125 millimetres square and coloured blue;
- (b) has been issued by a local authority and has not ceased to be valid; and
- (c) is capable of showing the quarter-hour period during which a period of waiting has begun.

(2) For the purpose of this Order a vehicle shall be regarded as displaying:

(a) a disabled person's badge in the relevant position when:

- (i) the badge is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle; or
- (ii) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia, the badge is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle;

so that the front of the badge is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle; and

(b) a parking disc is in the relevant position when:

- (i) the disc is exhibited on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle; or
- (ii) where the vehicle is not fitted with a dashboard or fascia, the disc is exhibited in a conspicuous position on the vehicle;

so that, when marked to show the quarter-hour period during which a period of waiting began, that period is clearly legible from the outside of the vehicle.

(3) Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

2. The restrictions, prohibitions and requirements imposed by this Order are in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any

other enactment and any exception or exemption to the provisions of this Order is without prejudice to the provisions of any other enactment.

## **PART 2: WAITING RESTRICTIONS**

### Prohibition of Waiting

3. Except as provided in Article 4 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the sides of road specified under Type 1 in Schedule 1.
4. (1) Nothing in Articles 3 shall make it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:
  - (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b) goods to be loaded or unloaded from the vehicle;
  - (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:
    - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
    - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of road; or
    - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said sides of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications system as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984;
  - (d) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
- (2) Nothing in Article 3 shall make it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, and a parking disc (on which the driver, or other person in charge of the vehicle has marked the time at which the period of waiting began) to wait on the sides of road specified therein for a period not exceeding three hours (not being a period separated by an interval of less than one hour from a previous period of waiting by the same vehicle on the same side of road on the same day).

### Limited Waiting

5. Except as provided in Article 6, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to wait between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday on the side of road specified under Type 22 in the Schedule:
  - (1) for a period of longer than 30 minutes; or
  - (2) if a period of less than 1 hour has elapsed since the termination of the said last period of waiting by that vehicle on the same side of road.

6. (1) Nothing in Article 5 shall make it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the side of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:
- (a) a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - (b) goods to be loaded or unloaded from the vehicle;
  - (c) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such a purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations, namely:
    - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
    - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic; or
    - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said side of road; or
    - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said side of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications system as defined in the Telecommunications Act 1984; or
  - (d) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road, to be used in the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties.
- (2) Nothing in Article 5 shall make it unlawful to cause or permit a disabled person's vehicle, which displays in the relevant position a disabled person's badge, to wait at any time on the side of road referred to therein.

### **PART 3: REVOCATION**

7. The provisions of Suffolk County Council (Various Roads, Framlingham) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Additional Measures) Order 2000, insofar as they relate to waiting restrictions on the length of roads specified under Type 6 and Type 22 in Schedule 2, are hereby revoked.
8. The provisions of Suffolk County Council (Parish of Framlingham) (Various Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Parking Places and Revocation) Order 1991, insofar as they relate to the waiting restriction on the length of road specified under Type 1 in Schedule 3, are hereby revoked.
9. The provisions of Suffolk County Council (Various Roads, Framlingham) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting, Prohibition of Driving with Exemptions, One Way Traffic, Parking Places and Revocation) Order 2008, insofar as they relate to the waiting restriction on the length of road specified under Type 1 in Schedule 4, are hereby revoked.

**PART 4: CITATION**

10. This Order may be cited as the Suffolk County Council (Various Roads, Framlingham) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Revocation) Order 2016 and shall come into operation on [REDACTED].
