1. Consideration of Objection to Waiting Restriction, Westley Road, Bury St Edmunds (Agenda Item 6 – 10 October 2016)

At its meeting on the 10 October 2016 the Committee deferred a decision on the objection to waiting restrictions at Westley Road, Bury St Edmunds and requested that Officers undertook further discussions with Councillors and additional consultation with local residents. The Committee also requested that consideration should also be given to an experimental order rather than a permanent one. The purpose of this Information Bulletin is to update the committee on this matter in particular the impact at this location of a closure of Newmarket Road to allow for the major remedial works to Westley Railway Bridge to be completed.

The closure of Newmarket Road (A1302) for six weeks from mid-February will have a signed diversion route via the A14 and the central interchange. However, there is the potential particularly for local traffic going to and from central Bury to divert via Westley Road. This should not include heavy goods vehicles as there is an environmental weight restriction at Westley. Nevertheless, it is considered prudent to prepare Traffic Regulation Orders for temporary waiting restrictions at various locations in Bury to assist with the managing of any additional traffic if required. One of these locations is Westley Road and the restrictions are similar to those proposed in the advertised order considered by the committee. It was agreed with Councillor Gary Green, Chairman of this Committee, and Councillor James Finch, Cabinet Member for Highways and Transport that this temporary restriction would serve as an experiment suggested by the committee. This will enable the impact of a permanent order to be judged more accurately and for further consultation with the local community during the restriction.

A full report updating the Committee on the results of the above will be made to a future meeting.
